



DBFZ SARS-COV-2- OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY STANDARDS

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VISITORS AND OTHER COMPANIES

- Only pre-registered visitors may enter the DBFZ premises. Please announce your visit in advance at your personal contact person. On arrival, contact the security guard, who will inform the respective employee at the DBFZ.
- Stay at home with respiratory symptoms or signs of illness, such as fever. In these cases, it is forbidden to enter the DBFZ premises. Exceptions apply in the case of a medically certified cold.
- Avoid physical contact and refrain from shaking hands with other people. Keep at least 1.5 m safety distance from other people.
- Wear a mouth-nose guard if you cannot maintain a safe distance from other people. Masks are compulsory in the incineration and compacting pilot plant.
- Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly. Liquid soap and towel dispensers are available in the sanitary facilities.
- Cough or sneeze in a disposable tissue or in the crook of your arm. Always turn away from other people. Then dispose of the tissue in a closed waste container.
- Preferably only use your own work equipment, such as a laptop or tools. It may be advisable to wear protective gloves.
- **If you fall ill with SARS-CoV-2 within 14 days of your visit to the DBFZ, you are obliged to inform DBFZ. Please inform your contact person or the safety expert Katrin Strach by phone at +49(0) 341 2434-560.**
